

Cemetery Refurbishing & Photography Kit

1. BUCKET: Container for rest of equipment and carrying of water and earth.
[Extra water in gallon jug for non up-kept Cemetery]
2. HAND SPADE: Dressing up earth at burial site.
3. HAND RAKE: Refreshing up earth at burial site.
4. GRASS TRIMMERS: Trim and manicure grass before taking pictures.
5. WHISK BROOM: Clean dirt, leaves & clutter from stone prior to taking photograph.
6. OLD TOOTH BRUSH: Cleaning in grooves of stone.
7. FLASHLIGHT: Using to bring out detail at dusk or poor light condition.
8. SPRAY BOTTLE: For wetting down small area of stone.
9. WASH MITT: For wetting down small area of stone.
10. UMBRELLA: Shading Sun or casting shadow on stone or camera.
11. REFLECTOR: Directing light into shaded area.
12. TRIPOD: Holding camera.

Other items:

1. TAPE MEASURE: For correct distance on fixed focus Camera's.
2. PAPER: For stone rubbing* [some cemeteries prohibit rubbings]!
3. RAZOR BLADE: Cut paper for rubbings or organic material.
4. LUMBER CRAYONS: For rubbing paper to bring about relief on stone.
5. TUBE: Controlling light on stone.
6. NOTEBOOK: Notebook, pencil to record any photographs, transcriptions etc.
7. SYPHON: For siphoning water off of flat tombstones.
8. COMPASS: For determining the direction of the Cemetery. (Hopefully, you won't get lost).
9. GPS: For determining the longitude and latitude of the Cemetery, graves etc.*

Please don't buy a GPS unit just for this Cemetery Project – Most Cemeteries already have been identified.

***Note: Please don't do anything that may destroy or damage a tombstone / property!**
